We have an exciting opportunity to work for our charity to develop our response to LGBTQ+ victims of DA across the organisation. We are seeking a passionate and enthusiastic development worker who is committed to partnership working with colleagues within MK-Act other agencies and engaging collaboratively with LGBTQ+ people, including young LGBTQ+ people aged 11-25. The role will include partnership working to create and deliver training and support services to address barriers to accessing support.

You will be passionate about developing creative initiatives in order to reach LGBTQ+ people who may be further disadvantaged by economic inequalities, disabilities or identifying as people of colour. We want to attract workers who will take creative and transformative approaches to working with LGBTQ+ people as well as being able to work with colleagues across the organisation and other agencies in improving their offer to LGBTQ+ communities impacted upon by Domestic Abuse. Ultimately, the post holders will aim to increase the numbers of LGBTQ+ people accessing domestic abuse services as well as feeling empowered to be more open about their sexuality and/or identity when accessing those services.
