The role will include partnership working to create and deliver training and support services to address barriers to accessing support.

You will be passionate about developing creative initiatives in order to reach older people who may be further disadvantaged by economic inequalities, disabilities or identifying as people of colour. We want to attract workers who will take creative and transformative approaches to working with older people as well as being able to work with colleagues across the organisation and other agencies in improving their offer to older people impacted upon by Domestic Abuse. Ultimately, the post holders will aim to increase the numbers of older people accessing domestic abuse services and tailoring the support that is required to their needs.

You will working across all MK-Act offices within Milton Keynes.
